Australian Teacher Aide of the Year Awards 2025 Conditions of Entry



NOMINATION ELIGIBILITY

- Nominations must include the name of a school leader (e.g Principal or Assistant Principal).
- Teacher aides, parents, and non-teaching staff are not eligible to nominate. However, they may suggest a nominee to a teacher or other member of staff with direct experience of the nominee's work, and assist in providing supporting evidence.
- Nominees must be employed at the school at the time of nomination.
 For team nominations, all members of the team must be employed by the same school at the time of nomination.
- The term "Teacher Aide" is an umbrella term and includes other work titles such as teaching assistant, learning support officer, education assistant, student mentor, etc. All such roles are eligible to be nominated.
- Nominations must respond to, and provide evidence against all criteria laid out in the 'Guide to writing a winning nomination' -

C1: Improve Professional Knowledge

C2: Enhance Student Learning and Wellbeing

C3: Collaborate with Colleagues

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- The nominations will be judged by a selection panel, who are representative of Government, Independent and Catholic schools, and Australian Teacher Aide.
- Panelists are not eligible to make a nomination.
- The decision of the panel will be final.
- Photos of Finalists and Highly Commended nominees will be required.
- Successful nominations will be published on the Australian Teacher
 Aide (ATA) website, in TA Talk, the ATA newsletter, and on social media.
- ATA may use nomination information, including nominee photos, on the Australian Teacher Aide website and in other media for promotional purposes.
