- 5. Timetable regular meetings with education support staff to review individual development goals, and reflect on professional learning.
- 6. Request education support staff bring a copy of their <a href="CPD">CPD</a> (Continuing Professional Development) diary, evidence of completion, and certificates to performance and development review meetings.
